## **JOHN 10: 22-35**

**22** Now it was the Feast of Dedication in Jerusalem, and it was winter. **23** And Jesus walked in the temple, in Solomon's porch. **24** Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, "How long do You keep us in]doubt? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly." **25** Jesus answered them, "*I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. 26 But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, [b]as I said to you. 27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. 28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. 30 I and My Father are one.*" **31** Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. **32** Jesus answered them, "*Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?*" **33** The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God." **34** Jesus answered them, "*Is it not written in your law, 'I said, 'You are gods''? 35 If He called them gods, to whom the word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken),*

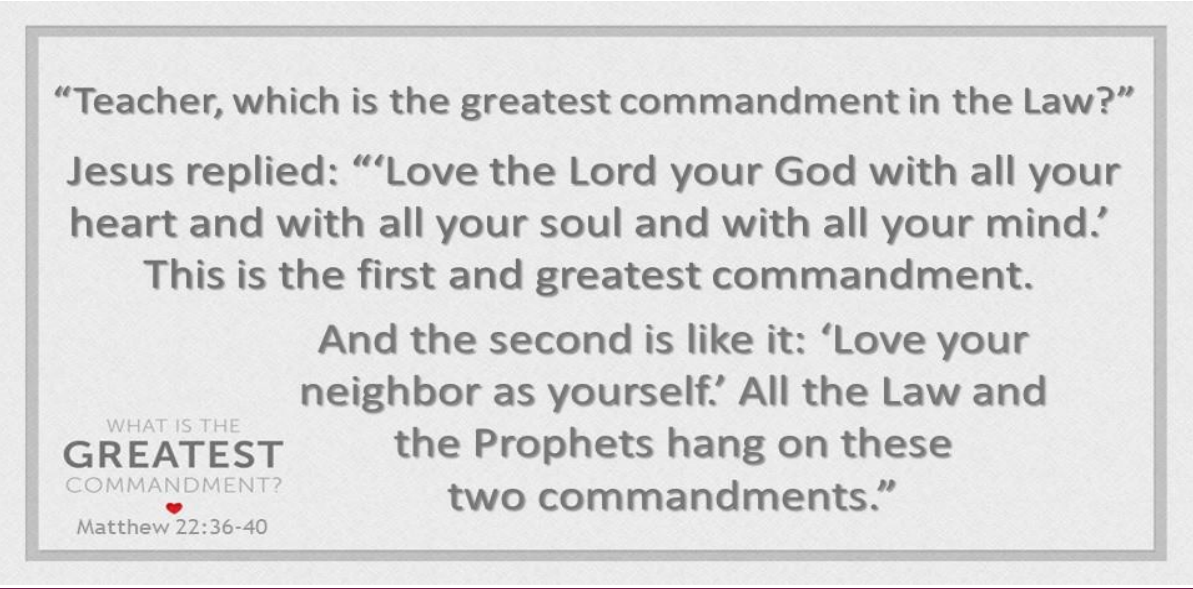
